RESPONSIBLE SERVER TRAINING

The purpose of the Responsible Server Course is to teach any person who sells or serves alcoholic beverages how to serve alcohol responsibly. Topics in this course include: how to spot a fake id, how to tell when someone is intoxicated, how to cut someone off when they've had too much to drink, as well as the State laws and legal responsibilities of a server.
