### **“CSI, N.Y.: Crash Scene Investigation, Lessons Learned”**

*This 3 hour seminar will focus on four crash scene investigations involving emergency services personnel in four key situations: a vehicle rollover, an intersection collision, a highway incident and a situation involving an emergency responder in a personal vehicle. Sound familiar? FASNY & VFIS have focused on a joint road safety training initiative since forming a partnership in 2003. The course instructor will present these four detailed incident scenarios, followed by an interactive group discussion of the NIOSH report, what went right, what techniques could have improved the outcome and what lessons were learned.*
