GENERAL INFORMATION

The Train-The-Trainer event is open to anyone. There are no pre-requisites or qualifications required to attend. Call **713-502-8470** to reserve your seat in class and to make payment arrangements. Seating is limited and your seat in class will be confirmed via email or fax when payment is received.

DATES – This 3-day training event will be held September 21, 22 and 23, 2007 in Hamlin New York.

LOCATION – The class location will be the Hamlin Fire Department, L R Merritt Hall, 1503 Lake Rd (Route 19) Hamlin, New York.

COST – The cost to attend this 3-day event is \$450 per person. This fee will include 3 days of training and all training materials. Lunch at the class site will be provided at no cost each day. Due to the limited space available in this class and the cost to duplicate and package all materials, the \$450 fee will NOT be refundable.

PAYMENT – Payment is required prior to attending class. OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Train-The-Trainer event is to provide you with all of the information and materials you will need to present our Accident Scene Safety training course to others. We will provide you with the training required to use all of our materials effectively. Each training Module is in PowerPoint format complete with videos.

The Accident Scene Safety course is divided into 6 Modules:

1. Vehicle Safety
2. Vehicle Design
3. Vehicle Restraints
4. Alternative Fuels
5. Vehicle Extrication
6. Vehicle Fires

Each module is divided into sections and designed as a stand alone program to allow you to teach any Module in any order you would like. Each section can also be taught independently to fit within time constraints. Each section can be printed from the DVD as an objective worksheet for your students to follow with room for notes and a post-test designed for the students to demonstrate their comprehension of the materials presented. The Instructors Manual contains all of the technical information needed to present the course along with a list of recommended hands-on evolutions to practice the procedures outlined in the course.

All of the training materials including the PowerPoint Presentations, Instructors Manuals, Objective Worksheets, Hand-Outs and Post Tests are on the Accident Scene Safety Training DVD. All training materials can be printed from the DVD as needed. As courses are updated and new courses are added you will receive all of the new materials and programs via email or DVD at no additional cost.

Accident Scene and Vehicle Safety is the focus of our training programs. Our programs are designed to enhance your current training, not replace it. Some sections of our programs can be used for training your schools and civic groups on basic safety issues while other sections will update the most experienced rescue worker. Our Accident Scene Safety Training programs allow you the flexibility to provide the greatest learning experience to the widest range of audiences.

Our Train-The-Trainer event teaches you how to use our programs to get the most out of each of your training sessions.
